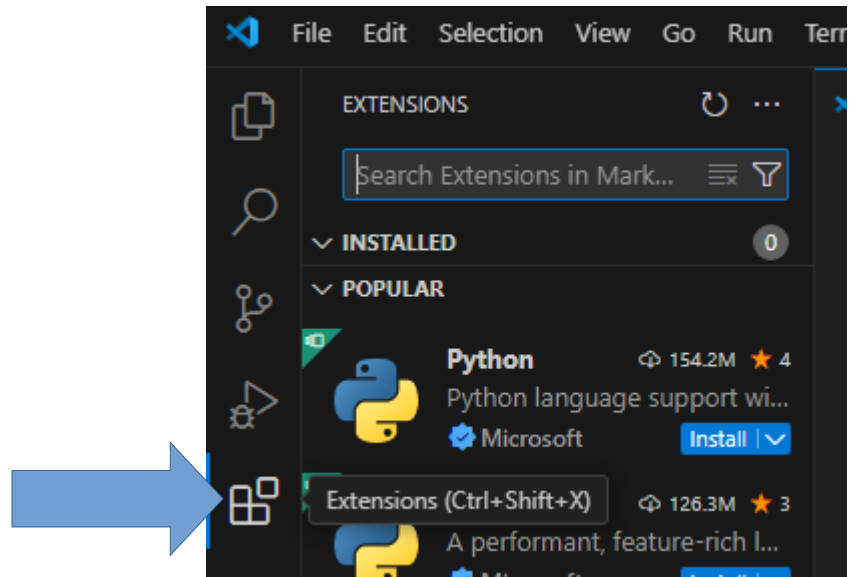


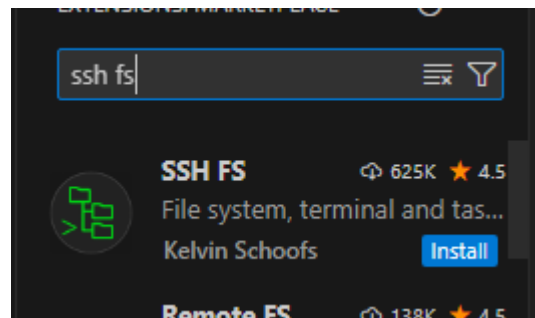
Setting up VSCode for our Web Server

Microsoft VSCode should be installed already.

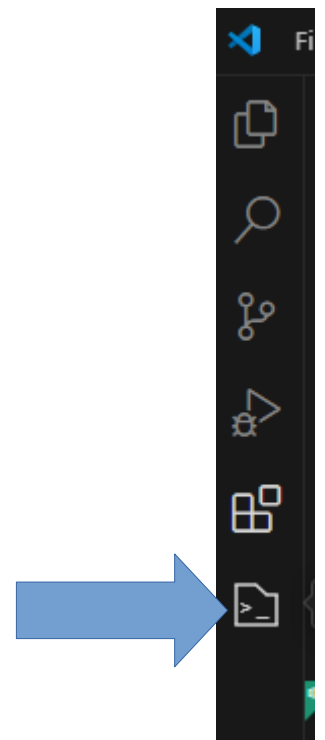
1. Install the “SSH-FS” extension:
 - a. Click extensions



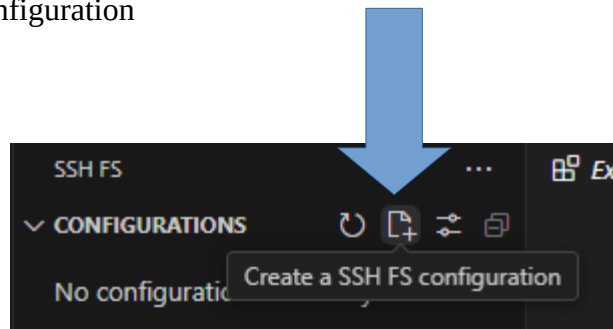
- b. Type in SSH FS and click install



- c. Once installed, click on the SSH-FS icon on the left bar



d. Add a new configuration



e. Name this new configuration:
dev.emmell.org and click **save**

f. Fill in the following details:

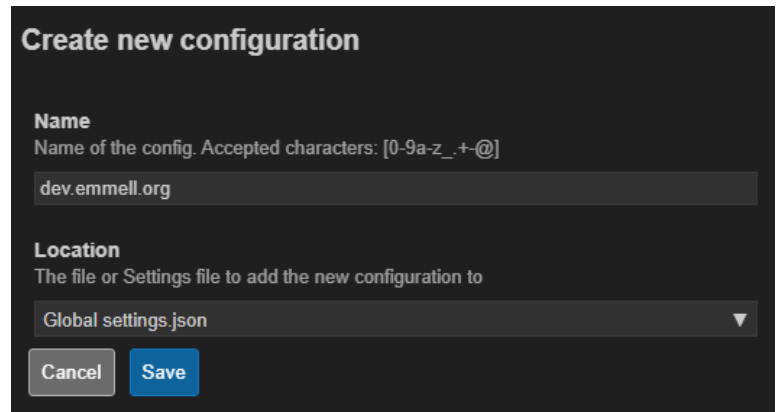
Host: dev.emmell.org

Root: /var/www/html/

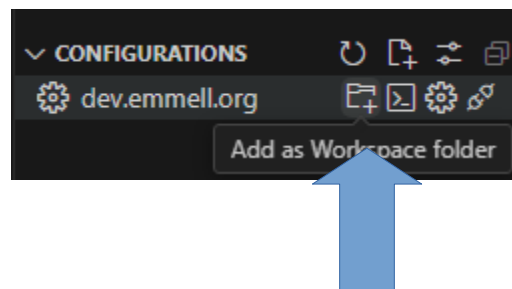
Username: as provided by Mr. Emmell

Password: as provided by Mr. Emmell

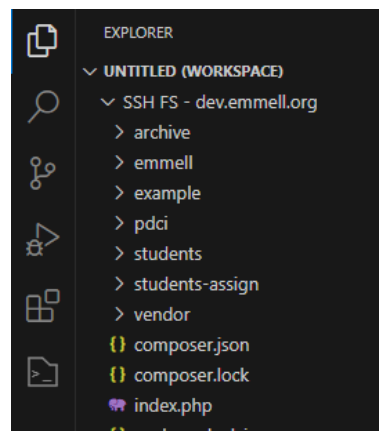
Click **SAVE**



g. Add this new configuration as a workspace folder



h. Patiently wait a little bit, and then see the new folder



2. Your mission?
 - a. Navigate to YOUR student folder, right-click to create a new file: hello.html
 - b. Type “hello world” – and save
 - c. Navigate to dev.emmell.org in your browser and see if you can find your work from the web page!
